WHAT IS BACK ON TRACK WA?

A first of its kind in WA, the Back on Track WA initiative will ensure children who go through cancer treatment do not fall through the cracks with their education due to the enormous strain treatment can have.

Working collaboratively with schools, families, friends and medical teams, the Back on Track WA program will ensure children have the chance to maintain and then get back into their education post-treatment, an opportunity we believe every child deserves.

The initiative will see specialist educators assigned to a child cancer patient following diagnosis that will remain with the child for their treatment journey and potentially beyond. Providing services such as tutoring and advocating with hospitals and schools. The educator will support the child, parents, classmates, and classroom teachers throughout the journey, offering guidance upon the often-daunting return to the classroom.

We will be there for your child and their families for their entire educational journey. We will be available for as long as they need us, all the way to their University graduation if they want!

WHY BACK ON TRACK WA?

● Staying Connected to School Life

Keeping our children connected to their 'normal' lives is vital in maintaining their desire to continue their learning journey and return to it easily. The benefit of having an Educational Advocate means that one person can liaise with all parties – schools, teachers, family, and the hospital, facilitating the aspects of education communication and delivery of work.

● Friends & Family Connections

When children are absent from classroom life for extended periods, it can be hard to retain a sense of connection with their peers. In addition to supplying education for your child, the advocate will support and enhance relationships to reduce the social anxiety of re-entry to the classroom.

● School Communications

Back On Track WA advocates aim to act as a liaison between the family, the school, and the hospital to assist the student's school to:

- meet the duty of care for the student
- advise on curriculum modifications and accommodations required
- address any Occupational Health and Safety issues related to the student's return to school

● Schoolwork

Back On Track WA advocates assist the student by working with their school to ensure that, where possible, they can work on the same activities as their classmates. Working within an empowerment model, the advocates do not determine the curriculum but facilitate, adapt and assist in completing work as set by the classroom teacher.

● Transitioning back to School and into their futures

The Back On Track WA advocates will assist in all aspects of the return to regular school attendance. We do not stop there; our program will be available to the child for their entire educational journey!

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Referrals

Students can be referred to the Back On Track WA Program at the point of diagnosis or beyond.

Who Can Refer?

They can be referred by their Oncology Team, their teacher or school, medical professionals, and parents.

Consent

After receiving a referral, our advocates will contact parents to set an appointment to explain the Back On Track WA program to everyone in the family. Part of the process is to seek the child's consent, where age-appropriate, to join the program.

School Engagement

Once the parent and child consent has been given, the Back On Track WA advocates will contact the student's school to explain how the program works for the school and the family and its potential benefits and encourage the school's participation. Attending the school is vital to build an Individual Education Support Plan to assist in creating educational support strategies.

Transitioning Back on Track

When the student is ready to return to their regular school routine, the Back On Track WA advocate will work with all stakeholders to ensure the transition back to school is easy and comfortable. The goal is advocacy to ensure the school's capacity to provide appropriate educational, emotional, and social support to the returning student.
